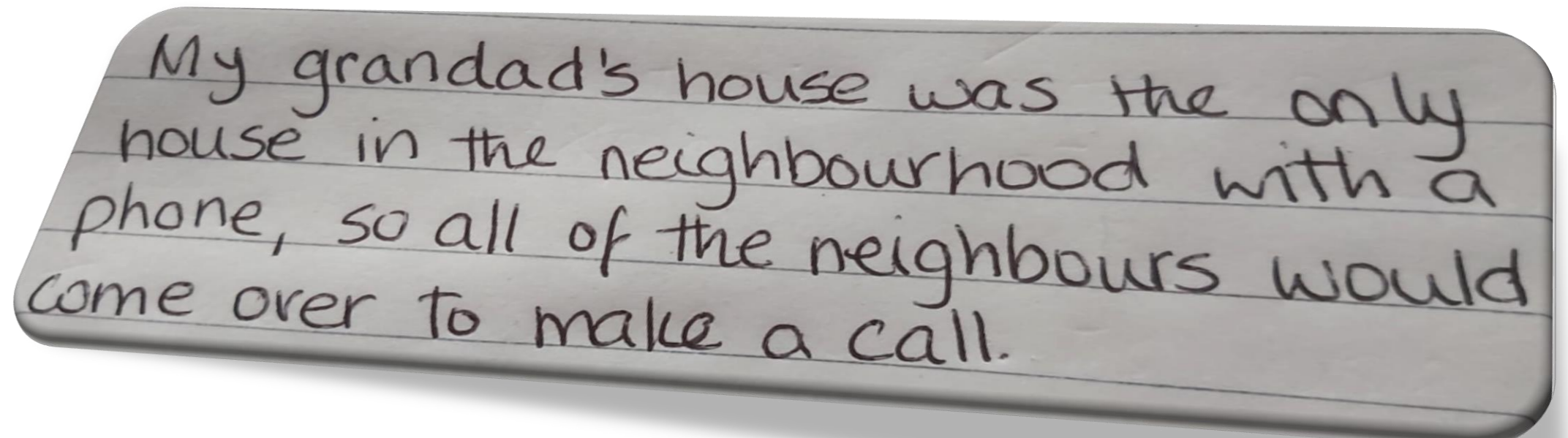
## Internet Inequality In Europe
